

itp's policy for REACH (Regulation EC 1907/2006)

In accordance with Article 33(1) of Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006, in the event that an article supplied by itp contains a substance meeting the criteria in Article 57 and identified in accordance with Article 59(1) in a concentration above 0,1% weight by weight (w/w), itp is required to provide its customers with sufficient information, available to itp, to allow safe use of the article supplied. This information must, as a minimum, include the name of the substance.

The European Chemical Agency (ECHA) published an updated list of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHCs) on the 4th February taking the number of SVHCs to 253.

itp is continually working with its suppliers to identify the presence of SVHCs in articles and materials used in its products. In the event that itp becomes aware of the presence of a substance meeting the criteria above, whether through its own evaluation and test processes or through notification by an upstream Actor in the supply chain, itp will issue appropriate notifications via the itp website <http://www.itp-probes.de> and/or suitable amendments to product literature. itp's SCIP information will also be updated to reflect these changes.
