

Conflict Minerals Declaration

To whom it may concern,

itp GmbH is committed to responsible and ethical business practices throughout its supply chain. We support the objectives of applicable conflict minerals regulations, in particular Regulation (EU) 2017/821 and Section 1502 of the U.S. Dodd-Frank Act, which aim to prevent the financing of armed conflicts and human rights abuses through the trade of certain minerals.

Conflict minerals are generally understood to include Tin (Sn), Tantalum (Ta), Tungsten (W) and Gold (Au), commonly referred to as “3TG”.

itp GmbH does not purchase raw materials directly from mines or smelters. Nevertheless, we work closely with our suppliers to ensure that the materials used in our products originate from responsible sources and do not knowingly contain conflict minerals from conflict-affected or high-risk areas that contribute to the financing of armed groups.

Based on the information currently available from our suppliers, we have no indication that the products supplied by itp GmbH contain conflict minerals that directly or indirectly support armed conflict or human rights violations.

itp GmbH follows a risk-based approach to monitoring its supply chain and, where necessary, obtains further information and declarations from its suppliers.

This declaration is based on the information available to us and our suppliers at the time of issuance.
